## **UN Depository Libraries System**

The system was born in 1947 with the aim of sharing UN documents and publications with a network of libraries spread in the world. So far the Depository Library Programme consists of 351 depository libraries located in 135 countries and 1 territory.

Once documents were sent by mail overseas from New York and from Geneva, today the sharing is done mainly on-line



## IFLA, International Federation of Library Associations and Institutions

The Association was founded in 1927 with the aim of representing the interests of libraries and information services and their users.
